

Dear Graduate Counseling Applicant:

This letter is to inform you that The Center for Relationship Enrichment (CRE) typically offers one new graduate fellowship annually to a student enrolled in the MFT or Dual Tracks. This Graduate Fellowship is normally awarded to an incoming student, but students already enrolled in the program may apply.

A graduate fellow has the opportunity to participate in a variety of CRE projects and activities such as research, teaching, workshops and curriculum development, as well as routine office tasks. Applicants must be enrolled as **full-time** graduate students and be available to work at CRE for 15-20 hours per week. An 18-hour scholarship is also awarded to students occupying this position each year (you **must** complete a separate scholarship application through the Graduate Counseling Department). This fellowship is usually a two-year appointment, although good academic standing, full-time enrollment and good job performance must be consistently maintained to retain the fellowship for a second year.

A description of the position, the application, and the reference forms are posted on our website (www.liferelationships.com). To apply, please complete all forms and return to the CRE office (c/o Jan Phillips at the address below) with **all** required documentation (hard copy please). Please also include a summary of your Christian testimony and current walk with the Lord, as well as a statement as to why you are interested in the graduate fellowship, how the fellowship contributes to your long-term goals, and possible ways in which your existing skills and experience might complement the work of the Center. Three recommendations are required to be considered for the position. One of the recommendation forms needs to be completed by your pastor or other applicable church leader. Please also include a detailed description of your skills and experience with software such as Microsoft Word, Power Point, and Excel.

Since we begin screening applications in February, you are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. **All applications are due in the CRE office by February 12, 2010.** Finalists for the position will be invited for an interview by CRE staff.
